Graduation Process

- Students apply for Diploma via GAU web Page
- Student Accounts approves Diploma Application
- Student must collect immigration approval (student permit copy)
- Faculty approves Diploma Application
- Student Admission Office Prepares Graduation Letter 2 weeks after Application submission
- Overall Diploma process including TC Embassy and TRNC Ministry of Education can be completed within 2-3 months approx. of initial application
- Approval obtained by Ministry of Health for Turkish Students
- Once the students Diploma is ready for collection, Turkish students have the option of having their diploma posted to their home address.



Graduation Process Cont.

- **Please ensure that you pay the required diploma fees and send a copy of your payment receipt to the Students Account Office via (ogrmuh@gau.edu.tr)**
- **Obtain your application form via (<https://www.gau.edu.tr/hizmetler/diploma-formu>) print, complete and sign.**
- **According to the recent decision taken by the T.R.N.C. Cabinet of Ministers you are now required to obtain and present a clear copy of your Entry-Exit form/document (obtained from the Police Station) and a copy of your valid student residency permit (muhaceret document) together with your diploma application form and submit them to your Faculty Secretary via email. If your application is incomplete your diploma application will not be processed.**

- **Please make sure that all the documents are in the right order.**
